• WHEN IS CAMP?

8:30AM to 4:30PM on Monday - Thursday and 8:30AM to 11:30AM on Friday for the entire family; Flag Ceremony, awards/special recognitions, and ice cream!!

• WHAT DOES THE CAMP COST?

CAMP CHENOA is \$150 per camper if registered by June 3, a late fee of \$30 will be applied thereafter

• WHO CAN ATTEND?

Any scout from any district who is entering the 1st - 5th grade in the Fall as **TIGERS, WOLVES, BEARS, WEBELOS I AND II**
**All campers MUST be registered as a cub scout at time of camp*

• WHAT IS THE ATTENDING-PARENT REQUIREMENT?

For each participating Cub Scout at camp, **our camps require an adult to attend for two-days during the week of camp** (assisting the den leader). The adult attending may be a grandparent or other family member, a paid childcare provider, or a family friend. *For those families experiencing a hardship committing to two days at camp, alternate arrangements may be available by communicating directly with the camp director.* Alternate arrangements may include paying a provisional opt-out fee of \$75/day, helping outside of camp operation hours (to prep materials) or by providing other needed services.

• INTERESTED IN VOLUNTEERING?

Cub Camp is an all-volunteer program. Camp Chenoa has approximately 15 adult positions to fill this year. A parent who can volunteer 4-5 days may receive a discount on registration for their scout. Are you a nurse? An EMT? health care provider? Volunteer as a **Health Deck Officer**. We're looking for **Den Leaders, station assistants**, and more. • WHAT DO SCOUTS DO AT CAMP?

Camper will be taught scout skills and the values of Cub Scouting through fun station rotations that will include:

- Archery
- BB Gun Shooting
- Nature/hike
- Wood Working
- Whittling (Bears/Webelos)
- Metal Pounding
- First Aid
- Local Hero Visits
- Campwide Service Project
- STEM Based Crafts
- Leathercraft

• WHAT SCOUTS EARN?

ALL scouts will earn: Shooting Sports Award I and II for BB and Archery and their Outdoor Activity Award. Scouts will earn 2-3 Cub Scout Adventure advancements and will have checked-off requirements completed in others. **Tiger** - My Tiger Jungle, Tigers in the Wild, Tiger Tag. **Wolf** - Paws on the Path, Call of the Wild, Hometown Heros. **Bear** - Bear Claws, Fur/Feathers/Ferns, Whittling Chip. **Webelos** - Into the Woods, Into the Wild, Whittling Chip.

• WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE CAMP COST?
