• Cub Scouts – Lion, Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelos, and Arrow of Light cloth badge and all required belt loops for each Cub Scout Rank. Elective belt loops are not included.

 with your unit committee and delegate responsibilities to ensure all measures are being met
 accordingly.
