## DISTINGUISHED CITIZEN DINNER

Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council, Boy Scouts of America honors leaders in our community that have consistent values with Scouting, while creating good news in a world where good news is not always in the spotlight.

In 2023 we are honored to recognize **Pepper Snyder** who exemplifies all the characteristics our future leaders should aspire to, lives the Scouting Outdoor Code, and exhibits an exceptional commitment to the value of being conservation-minded.

Pepper is a leader in wetland and waterfowl conservation both locally and internationally. He is the long time President of the Grassland Water District, which delivers water to the largest freshwater wetland complex in the West and is dedicated to the preservation of the Pacific Flyway. He is a director on the Duck Unlimited National board, the world's leader in wetland conservation. Through personal leadership, advocacy, and philanthropy, Pepper has dedicated his life to ensure that wetlands and wildlife will thrive for generations to come.

Scouting is raising the next generation of conservationists. An investment in Scouting is an investment in conservation and the young people we serve to help ensure future generations can gain an appreciation of nature and the natural world like the generations that have preceded them.

Currently, the Silicon Valley Monterey Bay Council serves over 8,000 young people in our local communities. It is our goal to double our impact by serving 16,000 young people in the next two years. To do this, we need to generate an additional \$2 million in new financial support; \$500,000 of which will be utilized to help offset costs for Scouts who could not afford to participate in Scouting otherwise; at-risk disadvantaged youth; and young people with Special Needs.

One of the primary ways we hope to accomplish this is through the generous support and sponsorship of this years Distinguished Citizen Party attendees and donors to help ensure we raise \$1 million (or more) so that we can positively impact more and more young people from all corners and circumstances in our Council territory.

Mitch Rossell's prolific songwriting and unique artistry caught the attention of Country music legend, Garth Brooks. Rossell joined Garth Brooks on his 2022 stadium tour with just an acoustic guitar, winning over thousands of new fans every night. In addition to opening for Brooks nationwide, Rossell has also written four of Brooks' singles, including "Ask Me How I Know," which landed his first #1 single. He also co-wrote: "That's What Cowboys Do," "All Day Long," and "Dive Bar."

In 2022, Mitch received a surprise introduction from Garth Brooks at his Grand Ole Opry debut, where he performed his singles "Son" and "All I Need To See." With another standing ovation in the books, Mitch's original music continues to capture the hearts of many, garnering over 91 million all-time streams.

After Mitch's outstanding performance on America's Got Talent earlier this year, "Son" hit #1 on iTunes all genres chart.
