Private Concert and dancing with Country Star Stephen Cochran

Eastern Kentucky born and Nashville, Tennessee raised, Stephen's musical influence began with his father's music career. Stephen received an offer for a developmental deal at the age of 19 while attending Western Kentucky University; however, the terrorist attack of September 11, 2001 redirected the already established patriotism inside Cochran and he joined the United States Marine Corps. Soon after, he achieved the position as a scout team leader serving in the invasion of Iraq and in Afghanistan. Ultimately, Cochran broke his back on the last security patrol of that mission leaving him without the use of his legs with the possibility of never walking again. After a long struggle, Cochran underwent an experimental procedure at Nashville VA Medical Center and after extensive rehabilitation, Stephen was able to return to an active lifestyle. He then refocused is energy on country music.

In 2007, he began Armed Forces Entertainment tours of the Middle East in support of our troops alongside extensive touring in support of his acclaimed, self-titled album.

In 2009 Stephen was named as a spokesman for the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to be the face of their research and development. He co-wrote "Hope," which the VA used as a theme song in its national campaign to help veterans.

Through multiple projects and collaborations since, Stephen has focused his efforts on supporting veterans and being a voice for them, helping them heal, and educating civilians about the veteran lifestyle, particularly the suicide epidemic that plagues the Veteran community.

In 2020, Cochran was contacted by Hallmark Movies to buy the rights to his life. A movie has been written and is awaiting production.

Stephen impacted country music with many hits such as (Friday Night Fireside, Pieces, She'll Thank Me Later, Wal-mart Flowers, and American Loser). "I was once known as the "Good-time, party guy" and even embraced it with songs such as "I'll Drink to that" and "Thinkin' I'm Drinkin'," said Stephen and continued to say, "But those that knew me, knew I had a deep desire for a family. It wasn't until now that I met my wife and truly began to live that dream.
