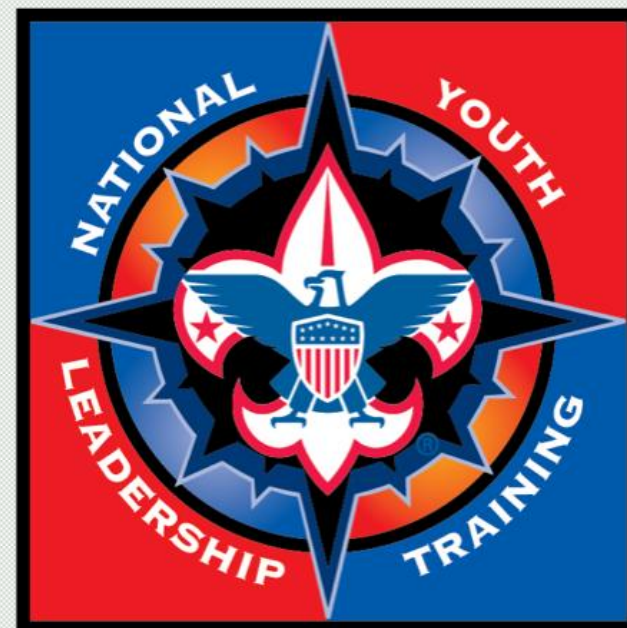

## PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 13 years of age when the course begins
- Be a currently registered member of Scouting unit
- Be First Class rank or higher and have taken ILST\* (Scouts BSA) or ILSC\* (Venturers).
- It is recommended to have at least one year of camping experience.
- Have unit leader recommendation.
- Provide a complete BSA Medical Form parts A, B & C

\*ILST and ILSC (Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops/ Crews) is the unit's version of leadership training. The name can differ from unit to unit.
